- 5. Support tougher sanctions

Tackle speeding

- 1. Increase speed enforcement
- 2. Support Community Speed Watch
- 3. Increase share of 20mph enforcement and support 20mph limits

Transparency and Accountability

- 1. Publish enforcement activity statistics
- 2. Publish a roads policing strategy/plan
- 3. Publish collision investigation outcomes
- 4. Commit to evaluation and scrutiny

Working with the Community

- 1. Promote third party reporting and Community Speed Watch
- 2. Establish Independent Roads Policing
 Advisory Groups
- 3. Fund community efforts
- 4. Adopt best practice standards

Improving the post-crash response

- 1. Support and survey crash victims
- 2. Ensure thorough investigations
- 3. Review 'No Further Action' injury investigations
- 4. Report the number of road crime victims
- 5. Treat crash victims as victims of crime until the contrary is proven
