AVZ blog on how few drivers convicted at court for speeding are banned (July 2021)

This shows how in 2020, only 39 of the 2346 drivers convicted at court for speeding were banned. And whilst 2020 is an unusual year, in 2019, it was only slightly higher with 56 bans given to the 3719 speeding drivers convicted.

AVZ Wide variation in traffic law enforcement (April 2021)

This blog/briefing provides a comparison of officer detected key offences, including speeding, between police services. West Midlands does not come out well. With speeding, WM Police officers detected 17.2 offences per 10KSI, compared to a national average of 21.9. And the average for the top five performing services was over 60, so over three times that of WM.
